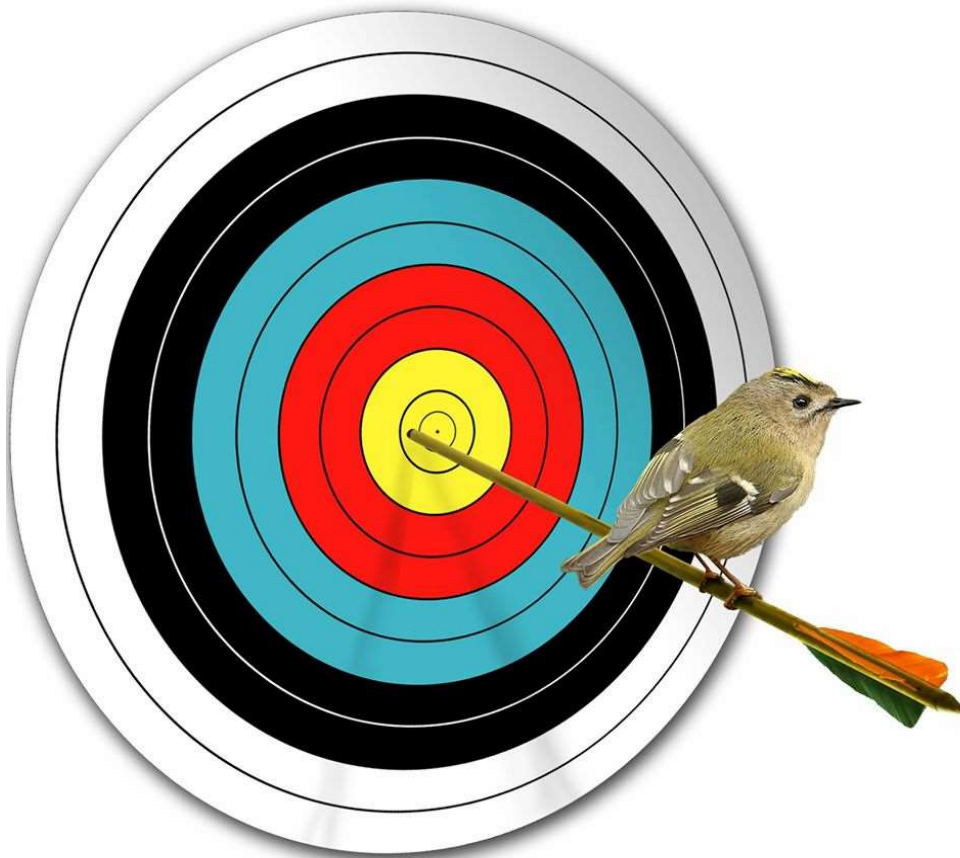

- Awards:** Medals, subject to entries to Lady, and Gent seniors and juniors –  
Compound, Recurve, Longbow, and Barebow. Other bow styles may shoot,  
but will not be rewarded.
- Faces:** Compounds will shoot on vertical 3 spot 40cm faces. All other styles will  
have the option of a vertical spot faces, or a full size 40cm face.
- Bosses:** All archers will shoot on layered foam bosses.
- Refreshments:** Hot, and Cold drinks, and snack will be available during the shoot.
- Drug Testing:** **Record status shoots are liable for drug testing, and any competing archer  
approached to provide a sample MUST comply. Failure to do so or a refusal  
will be treated as a positive test.**
- Photography:** In order to comply with the ArcheryGb protection of Children, and  
vulnerable adult's policy, those who wish to take photographs must register  
with the tournament organiser on arrival.  
Please be aware that Photography will take place during this event, and  
photographs may be used for club purposes, including social media.
- Disabled Archers:** The only access to the range is up a flight of 10 stairs. This should be kept in  
mind for any disabled archers wishing to take part in this event.
